



Encrypt with your Gmail Account

- 1. Sign into Gmail
- 2. Click Compose/Reply
- 3. Compose your message as normal, add any attachments (as necessary)
- 4. Turn on Confidential Mode by, clicking the <u>lock icon</u> at the bottom right of the message



5. The **Confidential Mode** window will open



- 6. Set Expiration and Password:
 - a. Expiration Date: Select one of the Available Options
 - b. Password:
 - i. If you choose **No SMS passcode**, recipients using the Gmail app will be able to open it directly. Recipients who don't use Gmail will get emailed a passcode.
 - ii. If you choose <u>SMS passcode</u>, recipients will get a passcode by text message.
 Make sure you enter the recipient's phone number, not your own.


*If SMS Passcode is selected, the phone number of the recipient is required to send them a SMS/Text Message with the passcode.

- 7. Click Save
- 8. The email is secured and you can click **Send** to complete the process



Opening an Encrypted Email (sent from Gmail)

1. Open the Encrypted Email and click on View the email



*If the email was configured with an SMS/Text Message Passcode, the recipient will see the following:

I. Select **Send Passcode**



II. Enter the SMS/Text Passcode and select the Submit button to open the secured message
